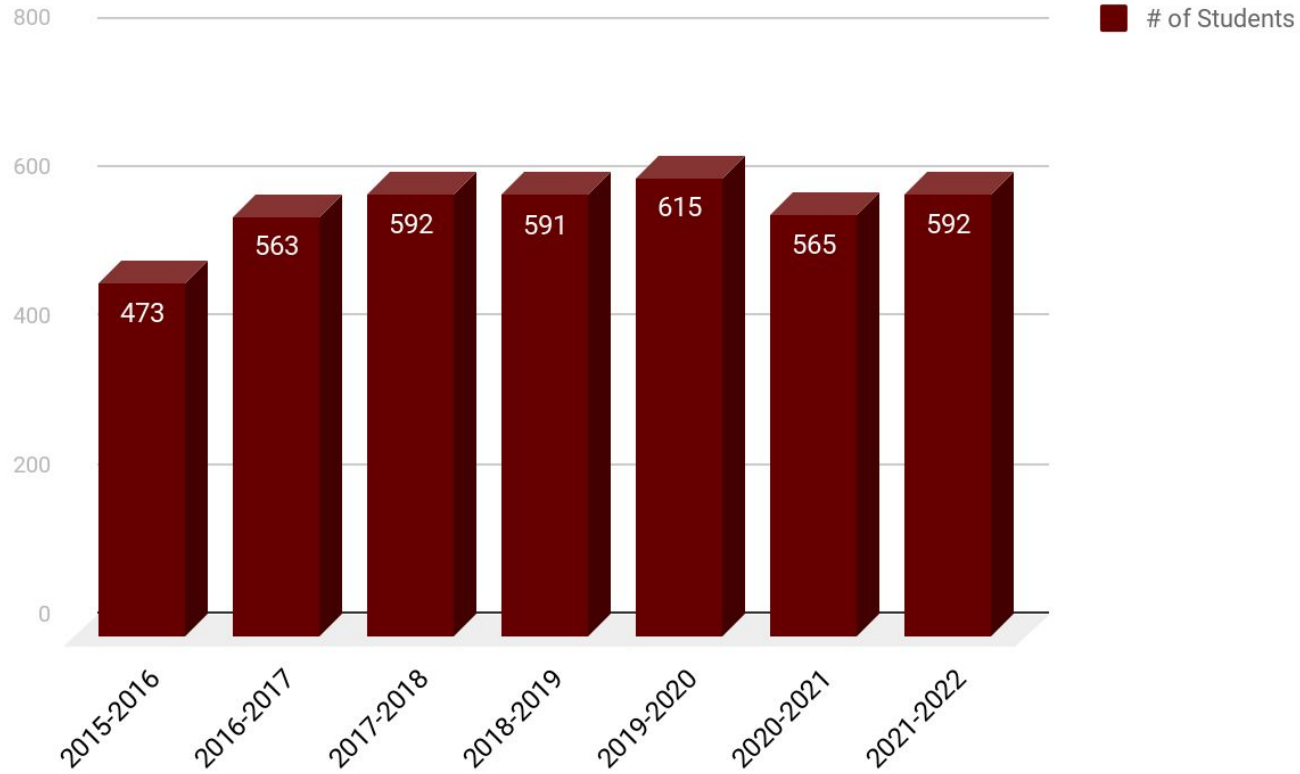

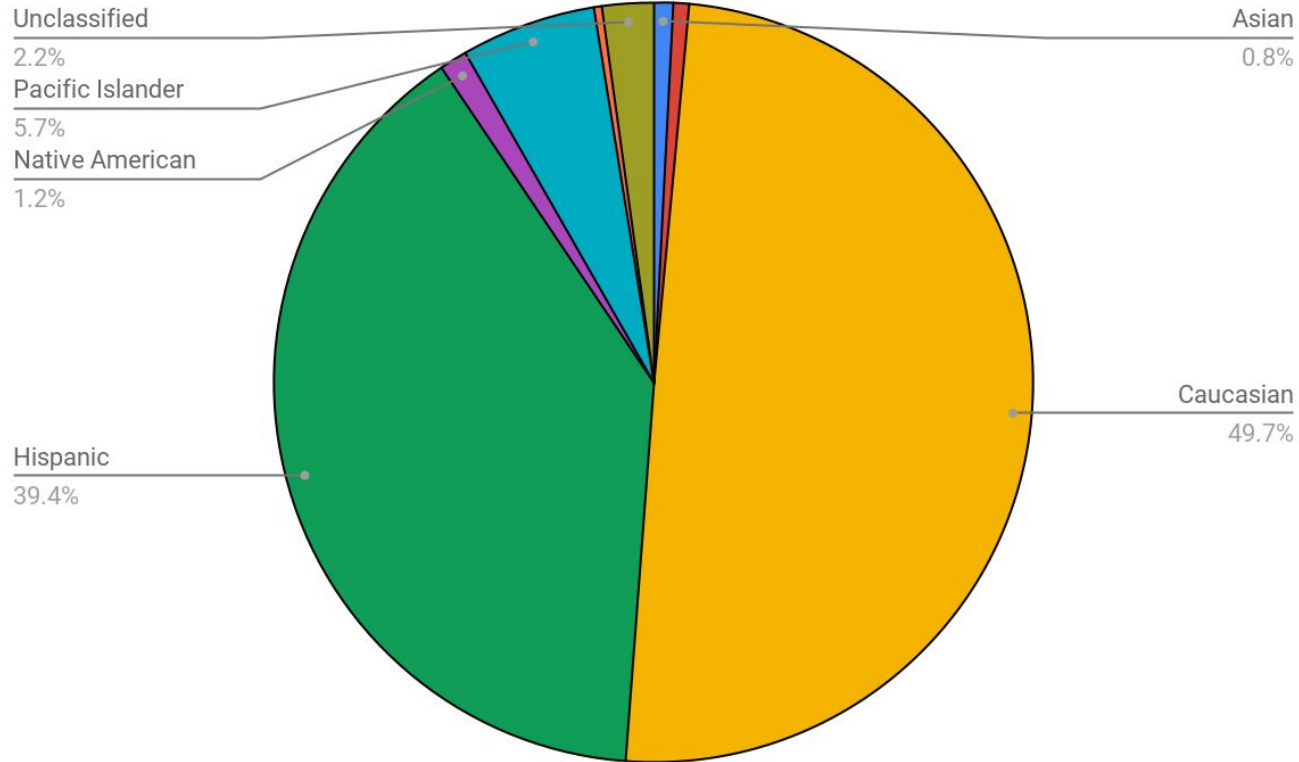
# VISION STATEMENT
